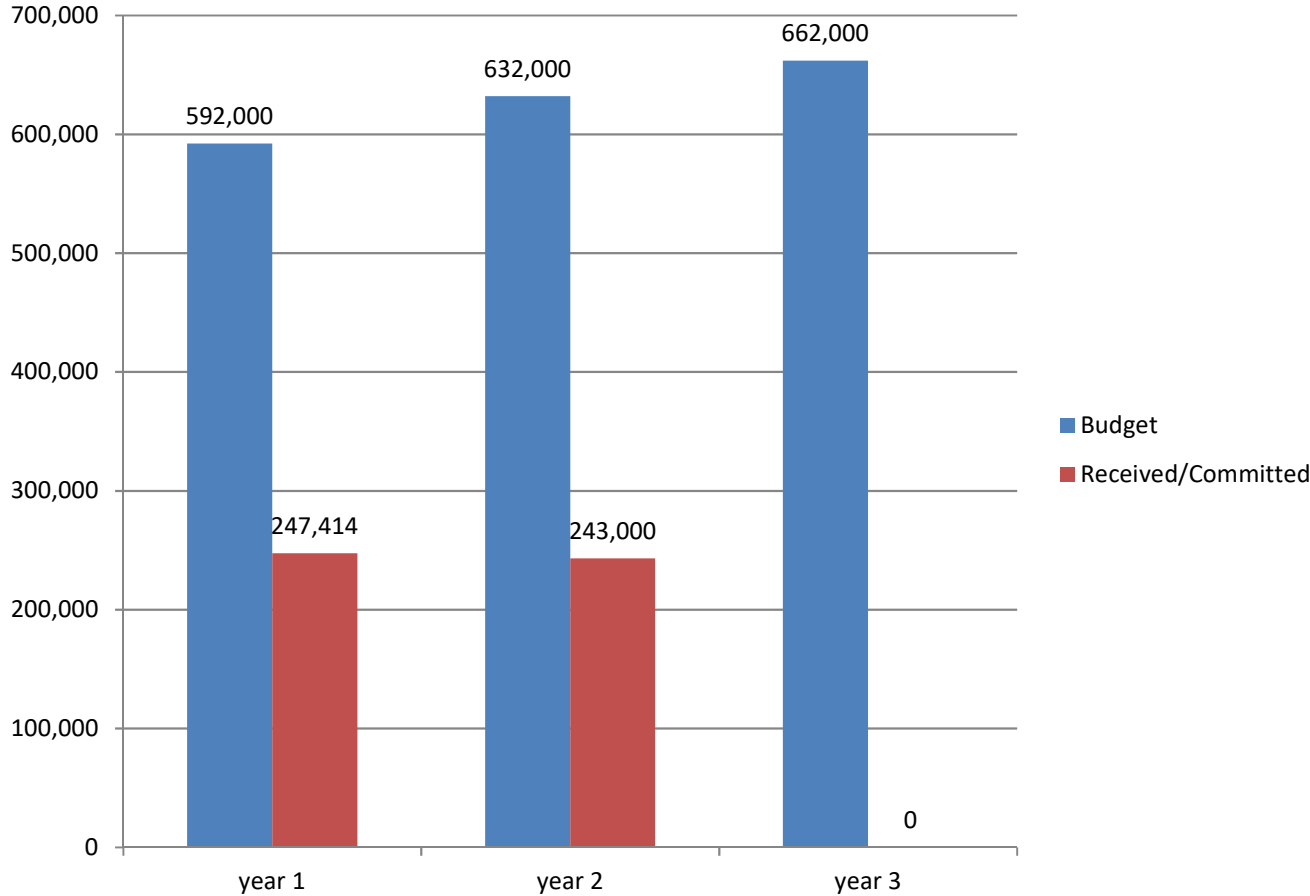
Coordination/Make it happen

 - UNDP PM
- Limited core funding to expand the team
- KM recruited only after Sida contribution
- Not sufficient funding for the Africa Coordinator function – now fully donor-funded JPO

Key Message

- LenCD has operated on a limited resource envelope in 2009-10 – 42% of 2010 budget
- Size and timing of contributions had implications on LenCD strategy and activities/results (i.e. contracts and core coordination team)
- Committed resources for 2011 only 38% of 2011 budget and not yet in hand
- Need to be able to rely on core resources to maintain core coordination functions on an on-going basis
